Description

You are to make `index.html` look exactly like `original_image.png` by implementing the necessary CSS to achieve this in a file called `style.css`, which is inside the `css` folder. The HTML component of the project is already in place; you only need to implement CSS. A perfect project will look almost identical to the original image. I will be using Firefox to check your project, so you're advised to use the same browser during development.

Rules

- You may not modify `index.html`'s contents or its file name; you must leave the file in tact.
- You may only write CSS.
- Your CSS declarations must be alphabetized.
- Except for a warning about UTF-8, your CSS must validate (use <http://jigsaw.w3.org/css-validator/>).
- Your CSS code must be neat and legible.
- You may not touch the directory structure of the project.
